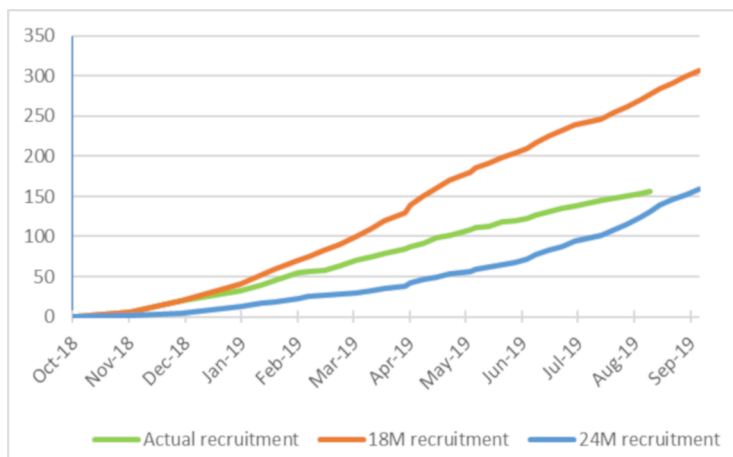
Most important TIPS & TRICKS to facilitate the recruitment of NEW patients:

- Train the physicians / nurses in the emergency room
- Train the new fellows working in cardiology, emergency, ...
