

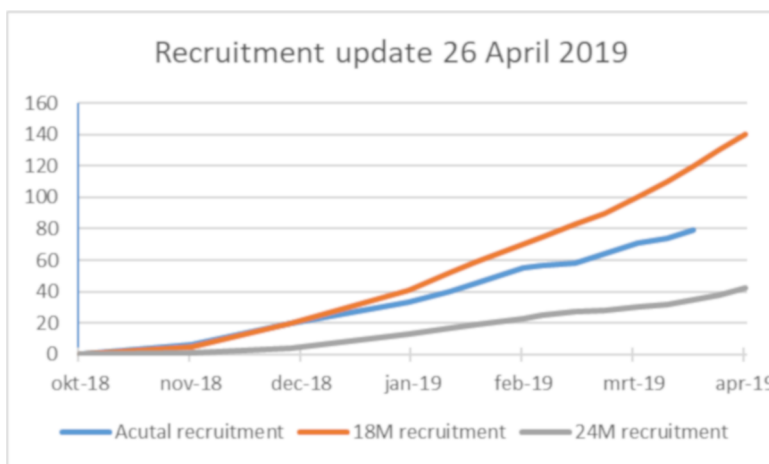
# ADVOR NEWSLETTER

April 2019

The substantial amendment has been approved resulting in protocol version 2.0. The changes have been described in the email d.d. 27/03/2019 sent to all investigators and study coordinators. All new documents related to the amendment are posted on [www.advor.be](http://www.advor.be). It is important that the study team is trained (self-study on training log).

From now on, please use **Informed consent v4.0** (13 March 2019) and **Inclusion and exclusion form v2.0**.

**86 patients** have been randomized which is within the planned recruitment strategy.



21 centers have been activated.  
17 sites have already included their first patient.

We are still hoping that **every center recruits at least 1 patient per month** in order to be able to close the recruitment in November 2020. Please contact the ADVOR team in case you need help with the recruitment process.



Congratulations to **Dr Blouard** and his team for being the top recruiter in the past months. The hospital Clinic Saint-Luc in Bouge recruited 6 patients over the last 2 months.

We would like to motivate all the centers to continue with the screening and recruitment of subjects for the ADVOR study.

## The laboratory sub-study has started.

Eight centers have already been trained regarding the sub-study procedures. Four patients agreed to participate in the laboratory sub-study, the first being included in OLVZ Aalst.
